### **United States**

- Long-Term Unemployed: 1.979M, increase of 5,000 since last month (unemployed for 27 weeks and over)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 9.5% (U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6))
- o **Job Openings**: 5.486M (*September 2016 preliminary*). This equates to 1.4 unemployed persons per job opening, or 2.8 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

### **Nonfarm jobs**: 144.952M (84.7% private, 15.3% public)

- Monthly change: +161,000 (+142,000 private, +19,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Education and health services (+52,000), Professional and business services (+43,000), and Government (+19,000)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since October 2015: +196,000
- O Compared to October 2007: 6.751M more jobs

The recession began in December 2007

### Initial Claims: 265,000

Weekly change: +7,000

Annual change: -13,000

Advanced October 29 seasonally adjusted regular UC program data; U.S. Department of Labor

Initial Claims: The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.

# **Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment:**

- Less than a high school diploma: 7.3%
- o High school diploma: 5.5%

- o Some College or Associate Degree: 3.8%
- Bachelor's degree and higher: 2.6%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- Nonfarm Jobs: 5.895M (88.0% private, 12.0% public; annual change: +0.9%)
- Regular UC Initial Claims: 55,400 (annual change: -7.1%)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 10.5% (BLS, 2015Q4-2016Q3)
- Online Job Postings: 369,600 (EMSI, 2016.4, September 2016 data). This equates to 1.0 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 1.9 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

- o Sayre borough: 6.3% (NSA)
- Nonfarm Jobs: 311,000 (87.8% private, 12.2% public; annual change: +0.3%) (NSA; includes other counties)
- Regular UC Initial Claims: 800 (annual change: -37.7%)
- Online Job Postings: 4,600 (EMSI, 2016.4, September 2016 data). This equates to 1.3 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 2.4 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 11.6%.
